Addresses himself as - "a bondservant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ,"

Four men named James in the New Testament:

- 1. James, the son of Zebedee and brother of John (Matthew 4:21), a disciple and apostle of Christ
- 2. James, the son of Alphaeus (Matthew 10:3), called "the Less" or "the Younger", also an apostle
- 3. James, the father of an apostle names Judas (Luke 6:16)
- 4. James, the half-brother of Jesus (Matthew 13:55) who became leader of the Jerusalem church (Acts 15:13; Galatians 2:9)

Responding to trials -



- •Testing of faith > Patience > Perfect







Responding to temptations -


- GOD cannot be tempted nor does He tempt us














The Letter of James Slow to SPEAK



Act wisely before speaking - James 3:13-18

James 3:13-18 NKJV Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom. (14) But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. (15) This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic. (16) For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there. (17) But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. (18) Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.


