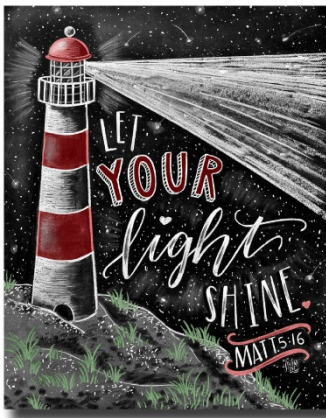

Biography of Arnold Garcon: He was born in Haiti; he was educated at Lipscomb University, Tennessee State University, BA, MA and Doctor in ministry from Emmanuel Theological Seminary and doctor in Business from School of Business. He speaks, English, Spanish, French and Creole, he married to Theresita for 33 years they have two boys, they are self-supported. Arnold is invested in real estate, shipping, farming constructions, he grew his own food, sweet potato, mango and plantain. He studied Spanish at University, Mexico City, Caracas. and Madrid and Barcelona Spain. He had preached for 36 years in four languages in more 25 countries. He never received a penny in Haiti and Latin American and Europe from any church or member in Haiti and Latin America he did it with love and generosity of good Christian like you. Arnold went to Spain last year several baptisms and restorations, Jan 2024 he went to Cuba 4 baptisms and several restorations. June 2024 he went to Peru bought many bibles songbooks some refugees were baptized and many restorations. Arnold did not take his wife with him if he did, he would not have money to give to the churches, preachers he used the money to help churches and preachers.

Continue to pray for safe return next week thank very very much for God to stop all the obstacle, problem, difficulty and snare of the Devil that will prevent him to return. Arnold will be going to Spain in September 2025 to reach Africans and he will fly to the island of Canaries about 15 hours fly to reach the Africans and in October 2025 Arnold will be speaking at the international Spanish Lectureship in Mexico. Arnold need a lot of prayers for safety travels, for God to protect him against all the dangers and to give him intelligence and wisdom to reach many people in English, Spanish, French and Creole, Arnold speak his languages fluently. Again, continue to pray without ceasing for the missionary journey 1 Tim 6:7 we bring nothing into this world we will go with nothing and 1 Cor 9:16 woe unto me if I do not preach the gospel Isaiah 6:8 *Arnold*
